



The Most Humane Organisation Award

Description:

This award is for the Organisation that has excelled in being Planet and People positive. Be it sustainability, mental wellness, diversity or other such critical agendas, the winning organisation will need to present a case where they have gone above-and-beyond merely following a 'top down' initiative. Past winners have demonstrated passion, and unique customised processes along with clear impact to people or to the planet.

The jury is looking for very specific details, for example in Diversity of it having it would very relevant to learn explicitly how the differently-abled and/or erstwhile ignored cohorts such as LGBT, transgender were employed or engaged in a non-discriminatory programme or practice.

The project impact data should be from the period between December 2023 and December 2024.

The project should be above and beyond initiatives executed in previous years - either new initiatives or previous years' initiative that have been materially stepped up.

Evaluation Criteria:

Overall

1. Presentation quality – written entry form and face-to-face presentation, finesse, clarity and brevity.

Award Specific

- 1. Clear articulation of the People or Planet positive aspect(s) of the initiative/programme
- 2. Demonstration of the impact
- 3. Commitment to this initiative/programme
- 4. Efforts the organisation continues to put towards being People and/or Planet positive (as something that is here to stay and grow).
